

## **SCHOOL IMPROVEMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE**

**SIAC overview:** To meet the requirements of Iowa Code Section 280.12(2), the All Saints School Board of Education appoints and charges a School Improvement Advisory Committee (SIAC) with making recommendations to the Board on an annual basis. Based on the committee members' analysis of the needs assessment data, **they will make recommendations to the Board about the following components:**

**1. Major educational needs**

**2. Student learning goals**

**3. Curriculum, assessment and instruction**

**4. Long range and annual goals that include, but are not limited to, the state indicators that address reading, mathematics, and science achievement**

**5. Bullying and harassment prevention goals, programs, training, and other initiatives**

**6. Any other issues which relate to school improvement**

The School Improvement Advisory Committee membership consists of representative teachers from across the district, representatives of the classified personnel, all building principals, the superintendent of schools, the director of curriculum, a guidance counselor, a school board member, parent members and student representatives.
