## Scrip Update:

**\*\*Scrip gift cards are available for purchase after masses this weekend\*\***

**It is never too late to start earning money towards tuition by getting started with our Scrip Program.**

What is Scrip?

1. Scrip is a gift card that All Saints purchases at a discount, then sells at face value. Each participating Scrip retailer has a gift card in varying denominations, with varying percentages.
2. The discount amount, aka. Scrip Rebate for each card, is then split 50/50 between the All Saints Technology Fund and the family who purchases scrip.
3. Each family's Scrip rebate accrues from May 16-May 15 each year, and is applied to the area of your choice, many families selecting Tuition expense reduction.
4. Many local area retailers and national retailers participate in scrip, offering scrip rebates from 2.5% up to 25!

Here's how to get started:

1. Stop by the Scrip table after weekend masses and place an order.
2. Let us know what area you wish to have your scrip earnings applied to-tuition, the Church, the Haiti Fund, the All Saints Scholarship Fund.
3. Start shopping
4. Any purchases now through May 15, 2018 will be applied towards Fall 2018 Tuition
