Preschool families - come to All Saints for old-fashioned carnival fun! There will be raffles, prizes, and games in store for everyone. What a fun way to end the school year!!



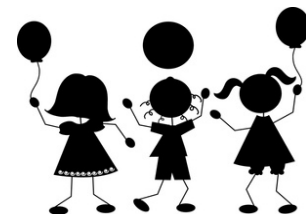
☺ Smile at a friend, It's Time Go ☺
