



All Saints Catholic School Dress Code

***Highlights reflect the changes within the dress code

The dress code of All Saints School strives to reflect neatness, cleanliness & Christian modesty while avoiding trends and fads. Students reflect pride in themselves and their school by the way they dress and act. It is expected that parents/guardians, working with the school, will require their students to leave home dressed in accordance with these regulations. The administration reserves the right to interpret dress code. The decisions of the administration are final.

SHIRTS -

- Solid color collared dress/polo/turtleneck shirts
- Plain short sleeve/long sleeve or tank style white undershirts may be worn
- Shirts must be tucked in at **ALL TIMES**
- Shirts must be buttoned to demonstrate Christian modesty (1 button from the top)
- Dress code shirts with the school approved logo may be worn
- Shirts that meet the All Saints dress code (color & style) with school approved Regis & Xavier logos may be worn

SLACKS -

- Solid colored black, navy blue, gray or shades of khaki
- **Trouser-style**
- Outside patch pockets are allowed only on the back of pant
- No rivets or outside seams with contrasting colors will be allowed

Not Allowed

- Knit pants, leggings, stirrup pants, and jean style pants.

SWEATERS/ SWEATER VESTS/ CARDIGANS/ SWEATSHIRTS -

- Solid color of traditional style and knit
- School approved All Saints/Regis/Xavier may be worn
- A dress code collared shirt or turtleneck must be worn and tucked in under the sweater/sweater vest/cardigan/sweatshirt

Not Allowed

- **Hooded items**
- Outerwear classrooms

SHORTS -

- Solid color black, navy blue, gray or shades of khaki
- Loose-fitting, walking-short style shorts must be worn
- Short length must be closer to the knees than the inseam

Not Allowed

- Cargo or jean style shorts

**Shorts may be worn up until Thanksgiving Break, and may return after Spring Break. Please note, it is the parent's responsibility to make sure his/her student notes the forecast for recess and is dressed appropriately.*

SKIRTS/JUMPERS/SKORTS -

- Skirts & Jumpers can be uniform plaid, navy blue or shades of khaki
- Skorts can be uniform plaid, navy blue or shades of khaki
- Length must be no more than 2 inches above the top of the knee
- Comfortable shorts or leggings (for colder weather) must be worn under the skirt/jumper of modesty

SPIRIT WEAR/ FREE DRESS DAY ATTIRE:

- Spirit Day is on the LAST Friday of each month (Spirit Wear can be worn that day)
- Free Dress days will be designated by the administration for the entire school or individually with a Free Dress Day Certificate
- Appropriate sweatshirts/t-shirts (no advertisements, inappropriate innuendos, or inappropriate graphics) can be worn
- Jeans or athletic pants may be worn
- Students not participating in free dress day must be in approved dress code attire

**Shorts may be worn up until Thanksgiving Break, and may return after Spring Break. Please note, it is the parent's responsibility to make sure his/her student notes the forecast for recess and is dressed appropriately.*

SHOES - Shoes must have a closed toe and heel. Sock must be worn.

ACCESSORIES - Items that are considered accessories include but are not limited to earrings, necklace, and rings. These items follow the "Rule of One" - one of each (pair of earrings, necklace, & ring) may be worn, but not in multiples. No make-up is allowed. Only females may wear earrings.

PERSONAL APPEARANCE - Clothing must be in good repair. No oversized clothing allowed. Any part of student's appearance that is distracting to the learning environment (as evaluated by a teacher or administrator/designee) is not permitted. Distracting appearance would include, but not limited to: hair color, body tattoos, or body piercing other than ear piercing. Appropriate measures will be taken when students arrive at school out of dress code which can include but are not limited to: giving a warning, changing into appropriate clothes provided by school's supply of extra clothing, or calling parents/guardians to immediately provide appropriate clothing. Parents of students who repeatedly disobey the dress code will be required to meet with the principal/designee.

SPIRIT WEAR - Spirit Wear consists of an All Saints, Regis, or Xavier shirt. This shirt can be worn with jeans or athletic pants. Knit pants, leggings, stirrup pants, slim-fitted jean style pants are not allowed.

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
