Where Are Your Scrip Earnings Directed To?

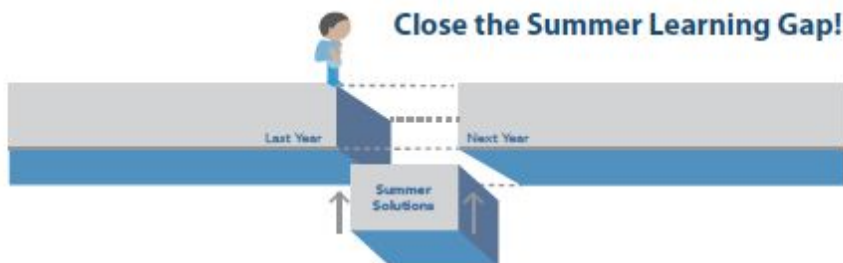
