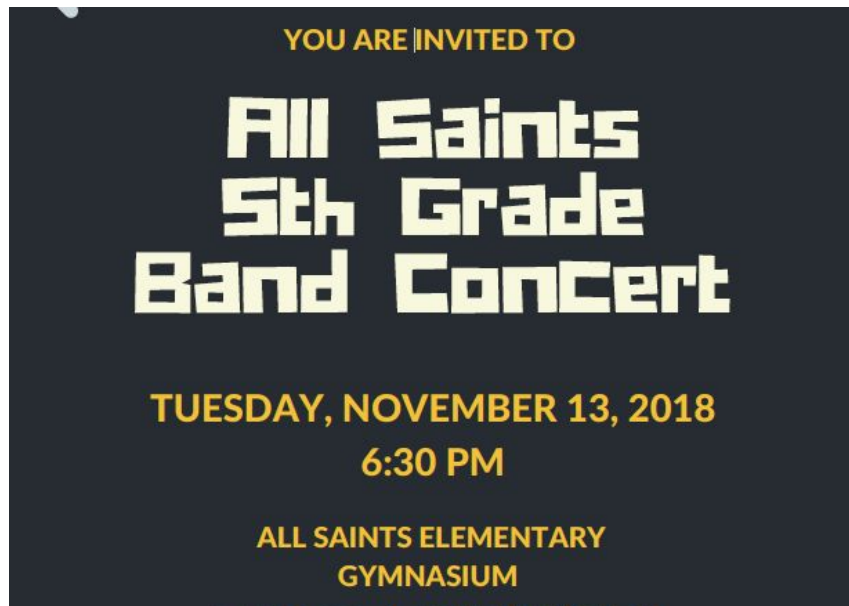

### **Transportation Reimbursement**

Students in non public schools may be eligible for a transportation reimbursement. If you live in the Cedar Rapids School District, live over two miles from All Saints and don't have CRCSD bussing available you can receive this reimbursement. If you live in another school district, you would apply for this reimbursement through that school district. First semester non-public transportation reimbursement forms for the area school districts are due December 1st. Click the district in which you live to find the form you need to submit. Remember Cedar Rapids school district forms need to be turned in to the school office. All other districts must be mailed to that district. ## **Saints Baseball 2018**

Registration is now open.

The Saints Baseball organization was formed seventeen years ago as a feeder program for Xavier High School.

Saints Baseball serves the Catholic community by providing competitive and recreational baseball for boys ages 6-14.

Why Saints Baseball? Joining Saints Baseball is a great opportunity for your child to grow as a player, while focusing on individual skills and teamwork. The teams will have access to nine ball diamonds located at various catholic churches and schools. The teams also have access to a great indoor facility called St Rita's year round, pictures are available on our website.

We start forming teams at 7U, available for kindergarteners and 1<sup>st</sup> graders, where the players focus on the fundamentals of baseball, the game schedule is usually pretty light at 8-10 games or so while they practice twice a week. The season typically starts in early April and ends at the end of June. Teams are formed based on school affiliation and friend request. We do not form competitive teams at this age group.

We are in need of 8U (2<sup>nd</sup> Grade) Boys as well. This is for our recreational team and can likely expect 10-12 games during the year.

This past summer we had over two hundred and fifty boys participate in Saints Baseball on twenty-four different teams.

Registration for the 2019 Season is now open for all age groups. Registration will end November 25<sup>th</sup>.
